


New Feature: Document History Box

August 17, 2010

The public search computers at the Middlesex North Registry of Deeds now contain a "Document History" box that documents all changes that have been made to an index entry. The feature appears as a red checkmark box on the document detail screen.



Click on the red check mark. *If no changes have been made, nothing will happen.*

If a change has been made to the index entry, when you click the red check mark, a popup box will appear documenting the date changed, the original value and the change made.

In this example, the last name was originally spelled **NQUYER**.

On August 4, 2010, the registry corrected the spelling to **NGUYEN**

To accommodate our normal index verification process, only changes made more than five days after the date the document was recorded will appear in this feature (although all changes are stored in the registry's computer system).

This feature applies to both Recorded Land and Registered Land.

REMEMBER – If nothing happens when you click on the Red Check Box, it means that no changes have been made to that index entry.
